Outcome 1.1 – Students will demonstrate knowledge of classical conditioning, verbal learning, and theories of learning

The metric to measure the success of this outcome is student scores on the knowledge assessment in PSYC 331. The target for each of the three years is that 70% of students will receive a minimum score of 70 or better.

Findings (2008-2010)

During 2007-2008, 2008-2009, and 2009-2010, 88.4%, 80.6%, and 87.5% respectively of the students received scores of 70% or better.

Action Plan Summary - 2007-2009

Continued attention to student learning styles and program assessment methodology.

Outcome 1.2 – Students will demonstrate knowledge of factors that affect vocational selection, aptitude estimation methods and measurement of special abilities

The metric to measure the success of this outcome is student scores on the knowledge assessment in PSYC 332. The target for each of the three years is that 70% of students will receive a minimum score of 70 or better.

Findings (2008-2010)

During 2007-2008, 2008-2009, and 2009-2010, 90.3%, 90.0%, and 89.3% respectively of the students received scores of 70% or better, indicating that the target for this outcome had been reached.

• Maintain focus on content delivery related to vocational selection and measurement.

Outcome 1.3 – Students will demonstrate knowledge of the causes of pathological behavior, preventive measures and remedial treatment

The metric to measure the success of this outcome is student scores on the knowledge assessment in PSYC 433. The target for each of the three years is that 70% of students will receive a minimum score of 70 or better.

Findings (2008-2010)

During 2007-2008, 2008-2009, and 2009-2010, 63.9%, 68.9%, and 46.7% respectively of the students received scores of 70% or better.

• Continuous review program topics to ensure currency of coverage.

Outcome 1.4 – Students will demonstrate knowledge of the development of personality

The metric to measure the success of this outcome is student scores on the knowledge assessment in PSYC 435. The target for each of the three years is that 70% of students will receive a minimum score of 70 or better.

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Findings (2008-2010)

During 2007-2008, 2008-2009, and 2009-2010, 95.8%, 74.6%, and 45.9% respectively of the students received scores of 70% or better.
