I want to introduce you to Texas Southern University's Summer of Success (SOS) Jumpstart Program! This is an excellent opportunity to jumpstart your success in your college journey. We look forward to serving you this summer through our SOS Jumpstart Program!

The SOS Jumpstart program consists of a five-week residential session. SOS Jumpstart is designed for you: (1) to improve your academic preparedness for college, (2) to assist you in preparing for the college environment, and (3) to give you a unique "early" jumpstart opportunity to begin satisfying college academic requirements. This year's program is July 10th- August 10th.

#### Here is what you can expect:

- The *residential program* is dedicated to mandatory academic enrichment programming. You will participate in college-credited classes, academic labs, and programming to introduce you to college life.


