### **Moving Your Belongings Out**

Bring your own packing and moving supplies.

Leave your keys and swipe cards on your desk in your bedroom, if applicable.

- There will be no room inspections upon check-out. However, egregious or intentional damages to the room may be charged to the resident.

If you have already moved all of your belongings out and do not need to return to campus, please contact housing at [tsuhousing@tsu.edu](mailto:tsuhousing@tsu.edu) to make arrangements for returning your key and getting officially checked out.

For students who do not have another option, University Housing and Dining may be able to provide emergency housing through May 9. Emergency housing will be in supplemental room spaces located in University Towers and some type of food option will be available.

Additionally, please be advised that for emergency housing:

- Desk services will be limited
- Lounges will not be open and there will not be residence hall programming
- No guests will be permitted
- There will be a 12am curfew

### **EMERGENCY HOUSING**

The University will review applications from students requesting emergency housing. Students will need to provide evidence of one of the following circumstances in order to qualify for emergency housing:

- The student's permanent residence is outside of the United States, and the student is unable to travel to that country.
- The student has personal circumstances preventing them from returning home and the student's current housing will not be available after March 28. Some examples include:
  - The student is part of the foster care system
  - The student does not have a permanent address
  - The student's home community is quarantined and they are unable to travel back
  - Returning home would present a health and safety threat to the student or individuals who live at the student's home
