IV. Library Learning Center

- A. Dr. Janice Peyton, Executive Director
 - Dr. Peyton welcomed faculty to continue to come and encourage students to use the product and facility; should encourage a collaborative relationship between faculty senate and librarians they want.
 - Question: Can we make requests?
 - o See website to request and reserve items.
 - o Budget -> based on \$500k. but over 4 years- so this year about \$100k. designated for books and eBooks.
 - o Requested books come through typically within 30 days depending on respective third party/publishers.
 - Four Liaison Libraries based on their background and/or subjects they are interested in -> no clear ratios.
 - Question about access to videos:
 - o If we can't access the journals faculty can ask for an inner library loan. Encourage faculty to use it/good for stats.
 - How is it determined what journal is purchased? First preference is having electronic access, additionally, the libraries use tools that are relevant to the field. Faculty members are contacted before unsubscribing to a journal.
 - Librarians are tracking student use of facility and library technology, including students utilizing the library's extended hours.
 - Highly encouraged involvement with the community, Dr. Peyton mentioned various community events that occurred in the library.
