Approval of the 7 February 2013 Senate Meeting Minutes

With one edit from Senator Brooks de Vita the minutes from February 2013 were read and approved.

Provost Dr. Ohia Q / A

Q: Senator Alexis Brooks de Vita, What is the process for students enrolling into a course past the 20 day enrollment deadline?

A: Provost Ohia, This should have been addressed.

Q: Senator Daniel Georges-Abeyie, What about book vouchers? Several student-athletes suggest the have book voucher, but are not purchasing their books for their courses?

A: Provost Ohia, This was addressed before. It should be noted that 95% of our student body is on some form of financial aid. Many students are filing their FASFA too late. So funds are not received in a timely matter.

Q: Senator Sharlette A. Kellum, An email was sent to a faculty member regarding underperformance and that they should attend TLEC. What is the mechanism to trigger a faculty member as underperforming?

A: Provost Ohia, Such language should not be used towards faculty. We, as a university, are measured by graduation rates. We should encourage faculty to understand that this is the case and the TLEC was developed to provide opportunity for our faculty to gain additional knowledge.

Q: Senator Robert Ford, Can you recommend to the president that TLEC become a remediation component? Peer review regarding remediation.

A: Provost Ohia, Suggest as the governing body come up with a recommendation of best practices for TLEC.

Statements/Suggestions

Senator Mosley, Students should be involved in the process. Senator Hawkins, Be mindful of negative thoughts on TLEC if it is viewed a punitive measure. Senator Mosley, What about positive intervention?

Provost Ohia, Remember administrators are faculty, as well.

Senator Daniel Georges-Abeyie, Graduation rates are not the only measure.

Senator Sharlette A. Kellum, Dean Bullard issued an emergency meeting for the Department of Administrative of Justice regarding possibility of losing program, could you expound on this issue?

Provost Ohia, Regarding (program) Doctoral Faculty in PhD program research is not where is suppose to be, in regards to publication, grants, and research. This is an issue at the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board level as well. We must address this issue.
